Whether you come to carve, model, or simply to enjoy the landscape and cultural programme, these two weeks are designed to be enriching, creative and restorative.

You will stay in a welcoming Alpine environment, enjoy excellent food, and share the experience with like-minded people from around the world.

Carvers' Programme

A relaxed start

Arrival on Saturday (or Sunday). Settle in without any rush, enjoy dinner and begin to acclimatise to your Alpine surroundings. On Sunday, take your time with a long breakfast, explore the village or enjoy a gentle walk. The first group meeting takes place on Sunday evening at 6.00 pm, where you will meet your instructor and fellow participants.

Course structure

Tutored carving sessions run from Monday morning to Saturday lunch, offering plenty of time to start and complete your work. Practical teaching is complemented by optional theory sessions held alongside the carving classes.

This year, we especially want to support you during the process of creating a carving from scratch. Therefore, there will be special theory classes during these two weeks, including aspects as sketching a project, concepts, creating a model etc.

Sat: 8.30 - 11.30

The first Saturday features a full-day excursion, together with the non-carvers. On the second Saturday, classes run until lunchtime.



October special courses

Alongside carving and modelling, the following options are available in October:

Week 1

Chainsaw carving | Painting and gilding



Week 2

Bronze casting | Woodturning

You may choose to carve, model, or combine different courses during both weeks. Many courses can also be booked for 2½ days, allowing you to mix carving with another craft and discover something new.

Non-Carvers' Programme

Enjoy the Alps at your own pace

The non-carvers' programme is designed for those who wish to explore the region, enjoy gentle activities and maybe take part in a creative workshop – all without carving or taking a week-long class.

Each week includes two half-day activities and excursions, offering a varied and relaxed programme in and around the Lech Valley.



Included programme:

- Apple strudel baking – prepare this classic Austrian dessert together
- Herbal walk with hands-on workshop (teas, balms or similar natural products)
- Pottery workshop: model your own bowls, cups or small vessels
- Second pottery session: painting and glazing, followed by firing. Your finished pieces can be taken home.



In addition, there is plenty of free time for walking, hiking, Nordic walking (poles provided), cycling along the Lech river, or simply relaxing and enjoying the Alpine atmosphere.

Non-carvers will also join the full-day cultural tour together with the carvers.

If one or more persons are interested in doing other tours we will be glad to help you to organize that for you. Please note that these tours are not included and will be charged - the price will vary depending on the number of participants.





Full-day Tour

One highlight of the fortnight is a scenic full-day excursion through the Alpine border region.

The journey leads through spectacular mountain landscapes and charming historic towns. Highlights include views of Germany's highest peak, the "Zugspitze", time to explore the well known Garmisch-Partenkirchen, a visit to Mittenwald, known for its violin-making museum, and a stop at the impressive peace bell overlooking the Inn Valley. The return journey takes you through varied Alpine regions, offering ever-changing scenery. The exact route may vary, allowing flexibility to choose the most rewarding experience.



Bronze Casting



In this course, you will create small delicate sculptures using the solid bronze casting process. Together with our course instructor, you will first model a wax model, which will then be professionally moulded, melted down and cast in bronze. While the moulds are cooling, the tutor will give a clear introduction to the theory on Thursday and demonstrate all the important steps involved in bronze and hollow casting. This will allow you to experience the entire creation process of your own bronze work up close.
